



Bible Ministry Worldwide The Facts & Figures

There are an estimated 6,900 spoken languages in the world today.

Bible Availability:

- **At least one Bible book** has been translated into **2,426 languages** - that's **35%** of all languages.
- There are now **438 languages** with a **complete Bible**. This is only **6.34%** of the world's languages. Bible Societies are currently involved in around 500 Bible translations.
- Up to **2 BILLION people** in the world today could not read a Bible, even if they had one. **Illiteracy & blindness** are the 2 major problems. Bible Societies face a huge challenge as a complete **Bible in Braille** is still only available in 45 languages. Audio formats are increasingly important.

Bible Society Structure

There are **145 Bible Societies** working in **over 200 countries**. They work as a fellowship to form the **United Bible Societies**, ensuring a **strategic approach** to Bible translation publication and distribution.

This combined approach worked to distribute over **391 million Scriptures** in 2007.
